

## BOARD OF SELECTMEN REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, November 14, 2013  
Shove Building Conference Room  
7:30 p.m.

PRESENT: First Selectman Gerald D. Stomski, Selectman Barbara K. Perkinson, Selectman George W. Hale, III; over twenty residents; two reporters

1. Call to order – First Selectman Stomski called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Privilege of the Floor – **Mr. Art McNally** – Mr. McNally thanked the Selectmen for their years of service and asked for the legal figures for the Region #14 School District Referendum court challenge. **Mr. Tom Arras** – Mr. Arras questioned the Council of Governments' response to zoning regulations for political signs. **Mrs. Claudette Volage** thanked the Selectmen and presented Selectman Perkinson and Mrs. Stomski with flowers. **Mr. Bob Willis** – Mr. Willis identified himself as a Parks & Recreation Commissioner and shared with the Selectmen his complaints about the Parks & Recreation Department. **Mr. Richard Snider** – Mr. Snider thanked the Selectmen for their years of service and commented that he had learned a lot about running the town by attending the meetings. **Mr. John Lewis** – Mr. Lewis complained about the Parks & Recreation Department and asked that the Parks & Recreation Commission do a full audit. **Mr. Joe Satmary** – Mr. Satmary thanked the Selectmen and noted that he thought they had done more to benefit the town in the last fifteen to twenty years than any others.
4. Minutes – Regular Meeting of October 24, 2013; Special Meeting of October 28, 2013 – MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved to approve the minutes of the Board of Selectman Regular Meeting of October 24, 2013. SECOND: Selectman Hale. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY. MOTION: First Selectman Stomski moved to approve minutes of the Board of Selectmen Special Meeting of October 28, 2013. SECOND: Selectman Perkinson. MOTION PASSED WITH SELECTMAN HALE ABSTAINING DUE TO ABSENCE.
5. Appointments/Resignations – none.
6. Bid Awards – none.
7. Donations - First Selectman Stomski stated that there was an anonymous donation to help some one in need regarding the Parks & Recreation Department's basketball program. MOTION: Selectman Hale moved to accept the donation of \$100.00 for the Parks & Recreation Department's basketball program. SECOND: Selectman Perkinson. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
8. Old Business – none.
9. New Business – none.
10. Correspondence – First Selectman Stomski mentioned receiving notification from Senator Blumenthal's office of two NEA grant opportunities; and a memo from the Recycling Ad Hoc Committee recommending: 1. Changing the sticker permit year to the fiscal year rather than the

calendar year, 2. Extending present sticker expiration date to June 30, 2014, and 3. Moving to implement single-stream recycling.

11. Adjournment – The outgoing Selectmen thanked each other for their efforts and noted it had been an honor and privilege to serve the town. MOTION: Selectman Perkinson moved to adjourn at 7:53 p.m. SECOND: Selectman Hale. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.


