Inground Swimming Pool Requirements

1. One set of engineered plans stamped and signed by a Connecticut Engineer. (Copied engineered stamps will not be accepted)

Engineered plans shall contain the following information:

- a. All structural information
- b. All electrical information (does not need to be engineered)
- c. All plumbing information (does not need to be engineered)

With the adoption of the 2011 International Residential Code, pertaining to Appendix G, under **Section AG106 Entrapment Protection for Swimming Pool and Suction Outlets** which states that suction outlets shall be designed and installed in accordance with **ANSI/APSP-7-06**.

2. Temporary Pool Fence Agreement must be signed by Pool Contractor or Home Owner.
3. Pool Fencing Agreement must be signed by owner.
4. Worker's Compensation form completed
5. Need to be a Licensed "Swimming Pool Builder" SPB (in-ground pools and spas only and for new installation work only). No person shall build a swimming pool unless such person holds a swimming pool builder's license issued by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection. A person licensed as a swimming pool builder pursuant to this section shall not perform electrical work, plumbing and piping work or heating, piping and cooling work, as defined in section 20-330 of the general statutes, unless such person is licensed to perform such work pursuant to chapter 393 of the general statutes. All types of maintenance and repair after C.O. / Inspection, must be performed by an SP-1 Contractor with SP-2 journeyman employees. A full-service contractor must have the Builder license and the Maintenance and Repair license for such pools and spas.
6. Pool Heaters per 2009 International Energy Conservation Code
7. Required signatures from other Town Agencies on Application.
