**The removal or replacement of a residential underground heating oil storage tank system has been included in the definition of a home improvement in Section 20-419 of the Connecticut General Statutes since October 1, 2004. Therefore, any contractor hired to remove a residential underground heating oil storage tank system after that date must be registered with the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection (DCP) as a Home Improvement Contractor.**

**Contractors must provide evidence of liability insurance coverage of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) and show evidence of completion of a 40-hour Hazardous Materials Incident Response Operations (HAZOPER) course and eight (8) hours of health and safety training – 29 CFR 1910.120(e), and passage of the International Code Council Decommissioning Exam.**
