(All work shall comply with the State of Connecticut Building Code and manufacturer's specifications.)

Note: The

State Building Code states that existing buildings undergoing alterations or installation of replacement windows shall be permitted to utilize removable sash to achieve the required minimum the required minimum net clear opening s for sleeping rooms. Such removable sash shall be capable of being removed without the use of a key or tool. The minimum net clear opening is 5.7 square feet or 821 square inches. If the window is at grade level then opening can be 5 square feet. Windows must also meet the requirements of the Energy Conservation Code which limits windows to a maximum U-value of 0.32.
