**Section 303. Elected State Officers and Terms.**

A. Registrars of Voters. There shall be two (2) Registrars of Voters who shall be elected for four (4) year terms at the regular State election immediately preceding the expiration of the term of office of the incumbents. The Registrars shall have the powers and perform the duties specified in the General Statutes. Pursuant to CGS 9-192 Each of the two (2) Registrar of Voters immediately after his election shall appoint a deputy registrar of voters to hold office during his pleasure and to serve in accordance with said statute. Each deputy registrar of voters shall regularly work in the Registrar's office and be trained a minimum of 40-hours per year.
