Hi Hilliary and Burt

Sal and I discussed the timeline. We also discovered that Secretary of the State recently released the 2025 election timeline, which is helpful in setting some definitive dates. Primary day will be 9/9/25 and only after the primary is completed can the absentee ballots be finalized. The recommended period to finalize and organize printing is 9/10/25-9/13/25. The absentee ballots then become available to the public on 10/3/25.

Based on Hilliary's suggestion of a 4/4/25 deadline to get the draft report to the The Board of Selectmen, the following dates would be applicable:

4/4/25 – Submission to The Board of Selectmen

5/19/25 – 45-day period in which The Board of Selectmen must hold a public hearing ends

6/3/25 – 15-day period for The Board of Selectmen to refer changes to CRC ends

7/3/25 – 30 day period for The Board of Selectmen and CRC to confer and CRC to make its recommendations on The Board of Selectmen's recommendations ends

7/18/25– 15 day period for The Board of Selectmen to vote ends

9/1/25 – 45 day period for peon to overturn denial by The Board of Selectmen ends

All of the timelines proposed anticipate using the full window of me. This is, of course, not a requirement.
