

CHAPTER II. THE TOWN MEETING

Section 201. General.

The Town Meeting shall be the legislative body of the Town, except as specifically provided in this Charter. It may act upon all matters upon which a Town Meeting may act under the General Statutes and upon all matters appropriate for legislative action under the General Statutes.

- A. ~~Eligibility to vote in Town Meetings and at any referendum held pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter shall be governed by Section 7-6 of the General Statutes.~~
1. ~~At any town meeting other than a regular or special town election or at any meeting of any fire, sewer or school district or any other municipal subdivision of any town incorporated by any special act, any person who is an elector of such town may vote and any citizen of the United States of the age of eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the town, district or subdivision for taxes assessed against him on an assessment of not less than one thousand dollars on the last-completed grand list of such town, district or subdivision, or who would be so liable if not entitled to an exemption under subdivision (17), (19), (22), (23), (25) or (26) of section 12-81, may vote, unless restricted by the provisions of any special act relating to such town, district or subdivision (Section 7-6 of the General Statutes)~~
 2. ~~Eligibility will be determined by the Registrars of Voters or their deputies using the official voting list printed not earlier than the day preceding Town Meeting. Non-electors (excluding eligible property owners) who attend the Town Meeting must be identified to the moderator, so they are not counted in any votes.~~
 3. ~~Electors (and eligible property owners) must be checked-in or in-line to be check-in with the registrar of voters or their deputies by the start time of the meeting in order to vote.~~
- B. All Town Meetings shall be called by the Board of Selectmen by a Notice as provided in Section 204 of this Charter.
