

## CHAPTER II. THE TOWN MEETING

### Section 201. General.

The Town Meeting shall be the legislative body of the Town, except as specifically provided in this Charter. It may act upon all matters upon which a Town Meeting may act under the **Connecticut** General Statutes **Section 7-1 to 7-9** and upon all matters appropriate for legislative action under the **Connecticut** General Statutes.

- A. Eligibility to vote pursuant to CSG 7-6 will be determined by the Registrars of Voters or their deputies using the official voting list printed not earlier than the day preceding a Town Meeting. Non-electors (excluding eligible property owners) who attend the Town Meeting must be identified to the moderator, so they are not counted in any votes.
- B. Electors (and eligible property owners) must be checked-in or in-line to be checked-in with the Registrar of Voters or their deputies by the start time of the meeting in order to vote.
- C. All Town Meetings shall be called by the Board of Selectmen by a Notice as provided in Section 204 of this Charter.
