Meeting Minutes

1. Meeting called to order at 7:07 PM
Members Present: David Taylor, Carl Samuelson, Kyle Turoczi, Jami Gore, Mary Tyrell, Carol Haskins.
Members absent: Jeff Sherman, Mike Lodice
Other attendees: Kathy Doyle
2. The Committee discussed the current status of the damaged riverbank area, specifically the tree lying in the river. Since the original breach in September 2023 the area has been hit by numerous storms which has laden the tree with debris and silt. Because the most recent storm did not move the tree we believe it is too heavily anchored and will not be moved without being broken up.
3. Motion proposed by Carol Haskins, seconded by Mary Tyrell:
"Suspend our work with Trout Scapes, plant the sloped area of the washout with native shrubs, and leave the tree in place in the river." Motion unanimously approved.
4. The plan will be presented to IWA at their 8/26 meeting.
5. Jami Gore and Carol Haskins discussed funding for the plants P&R and PRWC have sourced \$500 of the \$1,000 estimated cost. They expect to close the gap in the next few weeks.
6. Discussion ensued regarding the damage caused at 3 Rivers by the recent storm. The Committee believes it is essential for the Town to engage a Fluvial GeoMorphologist to build a comprehensive plan for the area. David Taylor and Kyle Turoczi will meet with Mrs. Perkinson to discuss.
7. Mr. Taylor introduced materials from the Mansfield farm lease process. The Committee will discuss this in the next meeting.
