MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING

Wednesday, May 28, 2025

PRESENT: First Selectman Barbara Perkinson; Selectman George Hale (by phone); Selectman Karen Reddington-Hughes (by phone); resident Burt Stevens, and clerk Deb Carlton

Phone calls were placed to Selectman Hale and Selectman Reddington-Hughes, who both remained on the line, on speaker, for the duration of the meeting.

Mrs. Perkinson called the meeting to order at 1:37 pm.

She reviewed a memorandum received from Town Attorney, Paul Jessell, which included all decisions reached by the Board of Selectmen at their May 22, 2025 regular meeting when the draft Charter was reviewed. Attorney Jessell also spotted grammatical and other reference type changes he recommended the Board support.

**MOTION:** *to send the draft Charter with the Board of Selectmen's recommendations as prepared by counsel to the Charter Revision Commission.* Entered by Mr. Hale, seconded by Ms. Reddington-Hughes, the MOTION CARRIED 3-0.

With no further business before the Board, Mr. Hale entered a *motion to adjourn*.
