To the Charter Revision Commission:

On behalf of the Commission for Seniors, it is respectfully requested that Section 602(I) *Commission for Seniors*, be amended as follows:

- I. *Commission for Seniors*. There shall be a Commission for Seniors consisting of (i) the Municipal Agent and the Director of Senior Services, who shall be ex-officio members without vote, and (ii) five (5) members, at least two (2) of whom shall be at least sixty (60) years of age, appointed as set forth in Appendix B as the terms of the incumbent members expire. There shall be two (2) alternate members, at least one (1) of whom shall be at least sixty (60) years of age, appointed as set forth in Appendix B as the terms of incumbent alternates expire. The Commission for Seniors is ~~an advisory body~~ concerned primarily with long range goals and strategic planning to advance the objective of the senior population. The Chairman or his or her designee shall be involved in the interview process, and the Commission shall make recommendations to the Board of Selectmen for appointment to the position of Director. It shall work with the Director to provide support and encouragement to the department and promote its mission in the community. ~~It shall review and recommend whether or not any gift, devise or bequest should be accepted and for what specific purposes it should be used; and~~ It shall have all the powers conferred on it and perform all of the duties required of it by law.
