Taxes Due July 1, 2022

Tax bills on the Grand List of October 1, 2021 will be mailed at the end of June 2022. **If you do not receive a bill and think that you should, please contact the Tax Office as soon as possible. Failure to receive a bill does not invalidate the tax or any penalties accrued per Sec. 12-130 of the Connecticut General Statute.**

Motor vehicle bills become due in full on July 1, 2022, payable by August 1, 2022. Real estate and personal property bills under \$100.00 become due in full on July 1, 2022, payable by August 1, 2022.

Real estate and personal property bills over \$100.00 are due in two equal installments, the first installment of which becomes due July 1, 2022, payable by August 1, 2022. The second installment becomes due January 1, 2023, payable by February 1, 2023. **No additional bill will be mailed for the second installment.**

Following the last day to pay of August 2, 2021, interest at a rate of 1.5% per month back to the original due date of July 1, 2022 will be applied on all delinquent tax balances, per Sec. 12-146 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

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Tax Payment Options

In Person

Office hours are Monday – Friday (excluding legal holidays), 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. and 1 – 4 p.m. If paying in person, bring the entire bill to receive a stamped receipt. Cash, check, and money order are acceptable as well as payment by credit or debit card (service fees apply to credit or debit payments).

By Mail

If payment is being mailed for the end of the collection period or end of the month, it is recommended that the envelope be hand cancelled at the Post Office counter to ensure an on-time USPS Postmark. Envelopes dropped in an outside mailbox may not be postmarked in a timely manner. Please send the proper payment stub with your check or money order. If a receipt is desired, send the entire bill along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

Online

Tax payment and information are available at woodburyct.org, accessible through the Tax Collector's page. Service fees apply of 2.95% on credit or debit payments (Mastercard and Visa are accepted). A flat fee of \$1.95 is applied to EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) payments.
