Planning Commission – Discussed at 12/04/24 meeting – The Chater should be revised to require the joint meeting to be held consistently each year in January (so all can be aware of when it will be held each year and so the new year can be started off fresh and all can be caught up with what the other commissions are working on). It was also noted that the joint meeting should be more structured and cohesive. Chair Connolly will convey additional comments discussed directly to the Charter Revision Committee.

Suggested rewording from Will, Town Planner.

Joint Meetings of Land Use Commissions and Officials. At least once each calendar year, with no more than twelve (12) months in between meetings The Board of Selectmen shall call and hold a joint meeting of all the land use commissions and all land use officials during the month of January of each year. to consider those items which the Board of Selectmen and the chairmen of the land use commissions have caused to be included on the agenda for that joint meeting. The Board of Selectmen may call and hold such joint meetings more frequently than once every twelve (12) months.

The Planning Commission would like to add that the focus of the agenda should be based on the Plan of Conservation and Development. Additionally, the land use commissions should include Park and Rec and the Shade Tree and Sidewalk Committees.

Joint Meetings of Land Use Commissions and Officials.

The Board of Selectpersons shall call and hold a joint meeting of all the land use commissions, all land use officials, and other commissions and boards whose activities rely on or impact land use in Woodbury. The meeting will be held during the month of January each year. The Board of Selectpersons and the chairs of the land use commissions will include specific items on the agenda for that joint meeting that pertain to the Plan of Conservation and Development and other pertinent Town regulations.

The Board of Selectpersons may call and hold such joint meetings more frequently than once every twelve (12) months.
