As a part of our twenty-fifth anniversary celebration, the PRWC looks forward to reinstating our yearly recognition of outstanding individual environmental stewards.

The Award was established in 2015 to commemorate the legacy of Dr. Taylor. One of the founding members of PRWC, Dr. Taylor's vision of and dedication to a healthy watershed for all continues to guide our organization.

Nominations will be accepted for individuals who have a similar commitment to the environment as Dr. Taylor did. Please be sure to include the nominee's name and contact details.

- Anecdotes detailing what makes them a "go to person" in the environmental or conservation arenas.
- Information about their role as a leader and collaborator to benefit the environment.
