ANNOUNCEMENT OF PUBLIC WALK May 16, 2024 WOODBURY ROUTE 6 CORRIDOR STUDY

The Town of Woodbury and the Naugatuck Valley Council of Government ([NVCOG](#)) is currently working with a Planning/Transportation Consultant Team and with the Connecticut DOT (CTDOT) on the [Woodbury – Route 6 Corridor Study](#).

The Project Team is focused on developing actionable concepts to improve safety, particularly for pedestrians and cyclists, while supporting economic development and preservation of the Town's historic assets. The Project Team is focused on improving Route 6 through Woodbury, from Flanders Road on the north to the Town boundary on the south.

Public outreach will play a key role in the success of this planning effort. To gather stakeholder and public views, and to hear directly from members of the community, the Project Team is preparing an Infrastructure Safety Walk Assessment. We will walk through Woodbury Center along Route 6, looking at real-time traffic patterns, noting key aspects of the corridor, and hearing directly from participants. This information that will inform the project recommendations.

All are welcome and encouraged to participate. **Participants will gather in front of Woodbury Town Hall on Thursday, May 16th at 1:00 PM.** The Assessment is anticipated to take roughly 1.5 hours.
