RECYCLING

Single stream recycling includes glass, cans, plastic, and paper.

These items should **not** be mixed in your household trash.

GLASS - includes clear, brown, and green food and beverage containers.

Preparation: Empty and rinse - discard caps in household trash

NO: drinking glass, light bulbs, ceramics, window glass, mirror, broken glass.

CANS - aluminum and steel - food and beverage only.

Preparation: empty and rinse

NO: hangers

PLASTIC - includes ketchup, juice, milk, detergent, bleach, shampoo bottles

Preparation: empty rinse discard caps in household trash

NO: black plastic, plastic bags, no foam

PAPER - includes waxed cartons empty and rinsed , milk, juice. cereal box, newspaper,

catalogs, magazines, envelopes, wrapping paper, office paper, cardboard,

shoe boxes. NO: Pizza boxes

ALL CARDBOARD FLATTENED NO larger than 3' x 3'

There are specified areas available for the mandated recycling of scrap metal, electronics, mattresses/box springs, motor oil/anti-freeze, and leaves.

ANTI-FREEZE - Deposit in labeled tank. ATTENDANT SUPERVISION REQUIRED

CLOTHING - drop off boxes available.

ELECTRONICS - TV'S, computer parts, printer, telephone, fax machine, microwave

NO: vacuums, toaster ovens, coffee makers, portable heaters

FLOURESCENT BULBS - placed in area where electronics are held.

NO: CFL's or broken bulbs

FOOD SCRAPS - fruit, vegetables, meat, bones, seafood, eggshells, coffee grounds,

tea bags, pasta, grains, bread, and any leftover food.

LEAVES - Foliage from trees - loose not bagged

NO: grass clippings, no yard waste

MATTRESS/BOX SPRINGS - Not accepted as recyclable if wet or frozen, severely

twisted, punctured, or crushed. Infested with bugs and/or living organisms,

moldy or excessively soiled.

SCRAP METAL - light metal, aluminum, copper, brass, pots, pans, empty dry paint cans

WASTE OIL - includes crankcase oil, automatic transmission fluid, hydraulic oil,

kerosene. Deposit in labeled tank. ATTENDANT SUPERVISION REQUIRED

NO: cooking oil

TIP: TO RECYCLE LATEX PAINT - REMOVE LID AND ALLOW TO DRY OR ADD SPEEDY DRY/KITTY LITTER SPEEDING UP THE PROCESS TO SOLIDIFY, ONCE SOLID AND/OR DRY DISPOSE AT TRANSFER STATION.

OIL BASED PAINT AND STAIN/VARNISH MAY BE BROUGHT TO MOST LOCAL HARDWARE STORES WITH A 5 GALLON LIMIT PER VISIT.

WHAT IS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Any waste product in the home that is poisonous, flammable, explosive, reactive, or corrosive is considered a household hazardous or chemical waste.

Some items are the following:

Disinfectants, drain and oven cleaners, metal polishes, toilet bowl cleaners, aerosols, wood cleaners, polishes and waxes, floor, upholstery and rug cleaners, bug, and pest spray.

Lead and oil-based paint, wood stains, varnishes, sealants, paint thinners, strippers, lacquer, lacquer thinner, fungicides, wood treating chemicals, automotive cleaners, grease, and rust solvents. Insecticides, poisons, pool chemicals and photo chemicals.

These items are NOT accepted at the Transfer Station.
