New Online Platform to Report Water Pollution Concerns to CT DEEP

The Department of Energy & Environmental Protection's Water Permitting & Enforcement Division ("WPED") is excited to launch a new online complaint intake platform supporting the State of Connecticut's commitment to develop new and innovative tools for the community to stay connected. The new online platform allows users to report concerns or complaints of water pollution to CT DEEP using an online electronic fillable form with mapping capabilities conveniently accessible through our website.

Effective June 10, 2024, the WPED will transition to this new online portal allowing us to respond to the communities' concerns of potential water pollution in a more timely manner. The online portal was designed to capture site specific information from the user to be used by our Compliance & Enforcement Teams to better investigate, coordinate, and respond to potential environmental concerns.
