

Woodbury Waste Advisory Committee Invites Public to Evening Meeting

WOODBURY, CT – With Woodbury’s permanent waste reduction program slated to begin in July, the ad hoc Waste Advisory Committee is inviting residents to attend their next public meeting at 7pm on Wednesday, May 15th at the Senior/Community Center (281 Main St South).

The Board of Selectmen initially formed the Committee to evaluate the success of the grant-funded Trash Reduction Pilot Program that ran from February 2023 to February 2024. After months of meetings, research, and input from stakeholders, the Committee recommended that the Board adopt a permanent version of the program with unit-based pricing and mandatory food scrap collection. The Board accepted the recommendation, and later reauthorized the Committee to promote, track, and educate the public about the permanent program.
